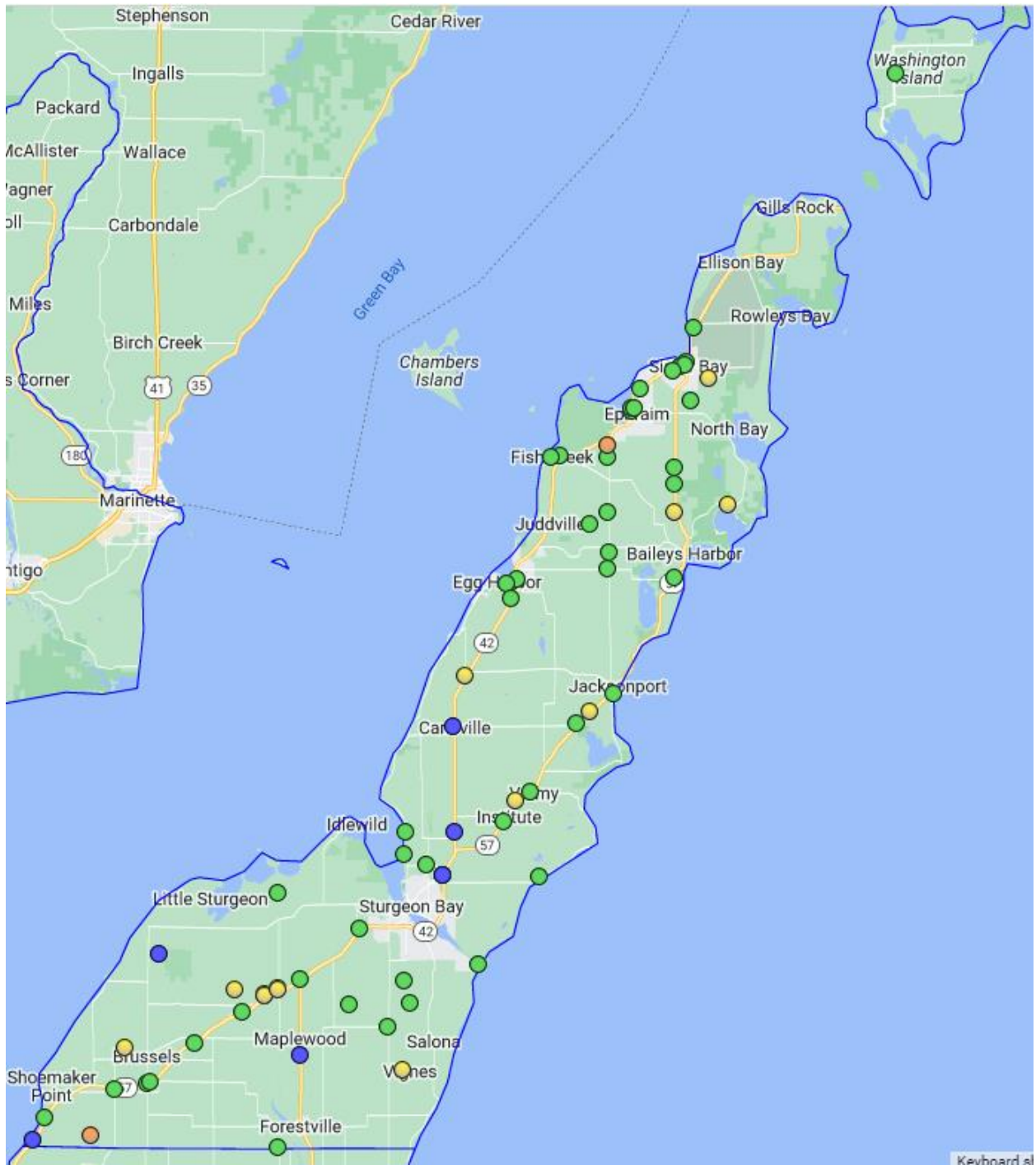

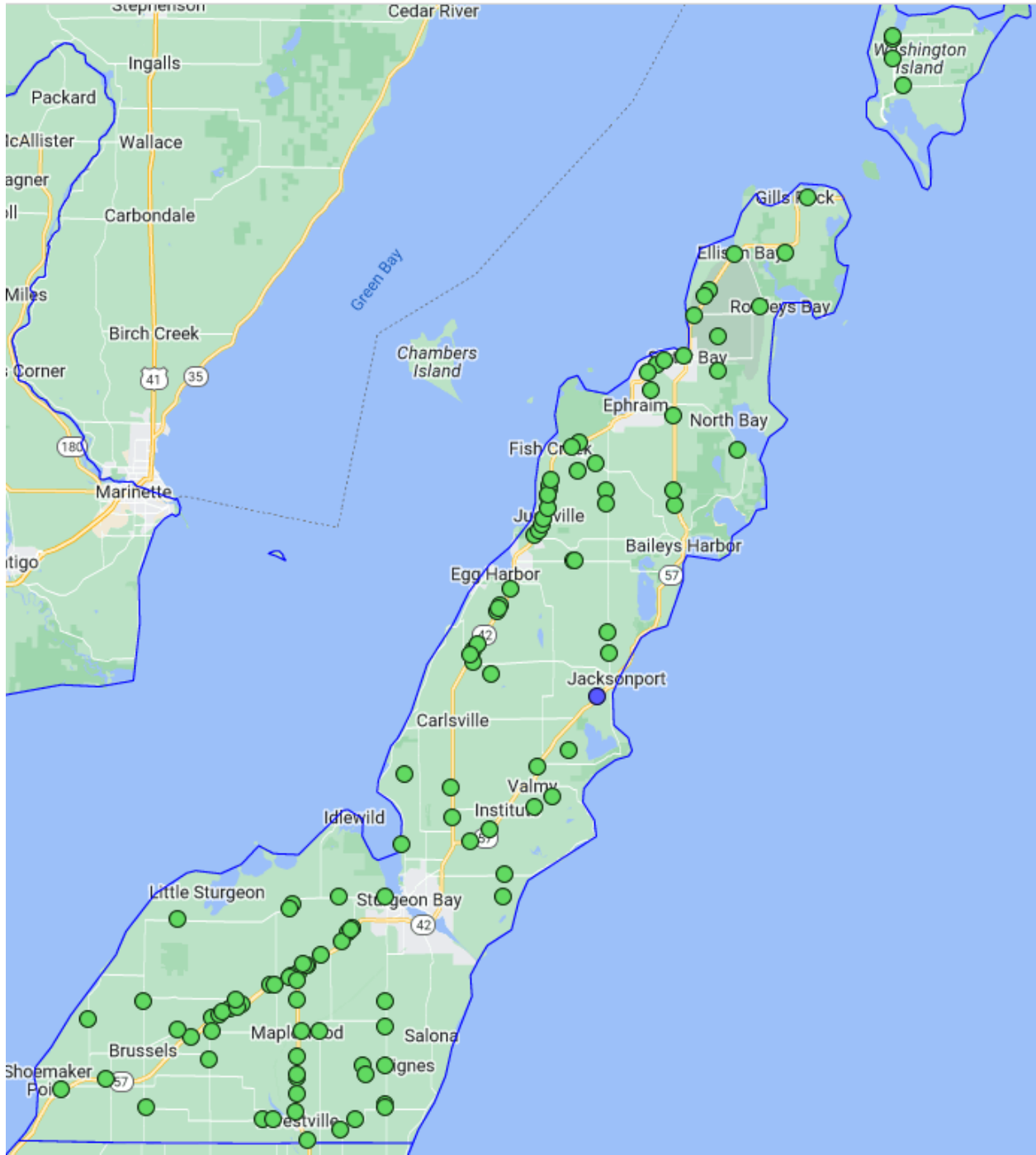
Minutes:

1. Call to Order – 9:00 a.m.
Chairman Roy Englebert called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.
2. Establish a quorum – agency representatives in attendance: Roy Englebert, Thad Ash, Clint Henry, Sean Donohue, Chad Shefchik, Brad Shortreed, John Sullivan, David Englebert, Aaron LeClair (online) Kim Bradley, Jenny Austin and Randy Wiessinger.
3. Adopt the agenda
Motion by Ash, seconded by Englebert, to adopt the agenda. Motion carried.
4. Introduction of guests: None.
5. Public Participation: None.
6. Correspondence: None.
7. Minutes of August 3, 2023, 3rd Quarter meeting
Motion by Henry, seconded by Ash, to approve the minutes of the August 3, 2023, 3rd Quarter meeting.
Motion carried.
8. Pending, continued, “old” business
 - A. Update: Intersection of STH 42-57 and CTH BB
Thad Ash said the project is complete. There is still education that needs to be done, but no complaints. The right-turn only going to the roundabout is working for what was intended.
 - B. Update: Highway Safety Issue – CTH DK and Cloverleaf Road
Ash reported that County Board passed the speed limit reduction to 45 mph, starting at the intersection of Stevenson Pier Road, north for approximately 2.3 miles to the intersection of Stone Road. Stop signs on CTH “DK” were also approved, but these are more of a timing thing. Highway is waiting for confirmation that the driveway has been abandoned or removed. The driveway needs to be abandoned first.
There were still concerns expressed, that access from 57 North is still going to be a problem. Further discussion held.
9. New Business
 - A. Safety Concerns: Starbucks exit to CTH S.
Ash has received several calls and concerns related to traffic turning onto South Duluth, with vehicles backed up into the State Highway. When Kwik Trip opens, traffic will only get worse. Shefchik noted that it has always been a problem with traffic back up on South Duluth. The problem is compounded now.
Ash said he’s not sure what the solution is, but wanted to bring this forward. Starbucks is using the existing driveway, which they widened. An existing driveway further south was removed. FYI only at this point.
10. DOT Update

11. BOTS Update (Bureau of Transportation Safety)
YTD Numbers
Randy Wiessinger reviewed data with the Commission. (copy of slides sent to Commission members following the meeting)
The biggest factors for traffic deaths and fatal crashes are speed and no helmet.
Wiessinger provided information about the new Judicial Outreach Liaison position. This is a liaison between the WI Highway Safety Office (BOTS) and the Wisconsin Judicial System to enhance traffic safety efforts. Wiessinger reviewed Crash Data Quality and the importance of narratives, focusing on what and how. Lastly, he explained the new Safe Roads Challenge app; a fun and engaging free app. It can be used for driver training, corporate partnerships, by employers and associations. There’s a lot of potential to this app.

12. Review of 'Spot Maps'

The second quarter had a total of 114 crashes (1 fatality, 65 injury), and 55 deer crashes (0 fatalities and 0 injury).
